A NOTECARDS

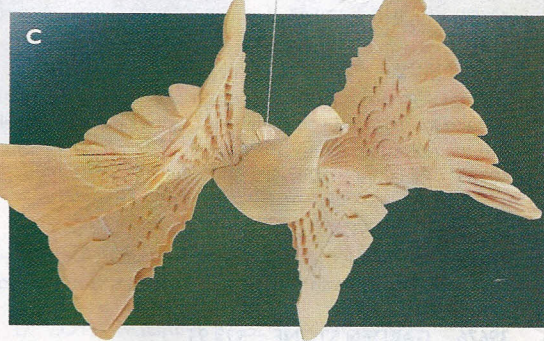
